

To: All HMO Insured Patients

Re: Authorizations

As per the contract with our therapy provider network, all patients with HMO insurance are required to have pre-authorization before beginning physical therapy. Please be advised that all authorizations have an expiration date.

Most authorizations allow for 12 physical therapy visits. ***Once authorization has been obtained, the duration of the authorization is determined by the treating physical therapist.***

The therapist and patient may determine physical therapy is to be terminated before the expiration date and before all 12 visits are used. ***This is at the discretion of the treating therapist.***

If the therapist and patient determine that physical therapy is necessary after the expiration date, it is your responsibility as the patient to contact your doctor for an updated authorization.
